New Sermon Series: "Great Is Thy Faithfulness" • Our faithful God is the One who has shown His faithfulness in every circumstance: His mercies are new every morning. He keeps every promise. He has been faithful to give His Son, Jesus, for the life of the world. And He has granted us faith to trust and rely on Jesus—pouring into us a faith that responds to His faithfulness and lives to make a difference in this world through the power of Jesus' love.

Today in Worship • **"Faith that Revives"** • **2 Timothy 1:1-14, Habakkuk 1:1-4, 2:1-4; Luke 17:1-10** • We live in a world that needs all manner of revival—above all, a world that desperately needs the new life that only Jesus can bring. We, too, need to be revived and renewed in our faith. The Holy Spirit that God has given us brings revival, fanning into flame the faith God has given us, filling our lives with courage and power, with love and self-discipline. Our lives are filled with purpose and grace because our God has been faithful to send His Son to conquer death and bring us new life. *What does a faith that is renewed and revived look like? How does that new life demonstrate God's faithfulness as we live out our faith in their world?*
