Today in Worship: Holy Trinity Sunday • Gen. 1:1–2:4; Acts 2:14a, 22–36; Matt. 28:16–20 • On Holy Trinity Sunday we ponder the mystery of how He has revealed Himself as the "Three-in-One" (Triune) God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Ours is the living God; gracious and merciful; all-powerful and eternal; with a love for all people beyond what we could ever imagine or deserve. Bible Classes

Adult Sunday Morning Bible Class at 10:00 am • The class is led by Jim Essig. We are looking at the Gospel of Luke. Classes are in the Music Room during our 10:00 am Education Hour, between the 9 am & 11 am worship services. SUNDAY SCHOOL FOR AGE 4 – GRADE 5: Foundations of Faith • Kids will make crafts, play games, and learn the basic truths about God using both Old Testament and New Testament stories. Kids will walk away from each class with a new "God is..." statement (i.e. "God is powerful" or "God is kind") and what it means that we are God's people. Sunday School meets upstairs in the Family Life Center classrooms from 10:00-10:45 on Sunday mornings.
