Today: "Jesus, the Righteous King" • Ezekiel 34:11–16, 20–24; Psalm 95:1–7; 1 Corinthians 15:20–28; Matthew 25:31–46 • This Sunday is Christ the King Sunday. We celebrate Christ's reign among us. As the creator of the universe and ruler of all, it is no small thing that He has called us to be His people and placed us under His reign.
