#### FIRST LESSON

GENESIS 17:1-7, 15-16

R: The First lesson for this Second Sunday in Lent is from the seventeenth chapter of Genesis.

When Abram was ninety-nine years old, the Lord appeared to him and said, "I am God Almighty; walk before me faithfully and be blameless. Then I will make my covenant between me and you and will greatly increase your numbers."
