Today: "Religion or Relationship" • Exodus 20:1-17; 1 Corinthians 1:18-31; John 2:13-22 • Is Christianity more of a religion, or a relationship? As we look at the Ten Commandments we consider that question: religion, or relationship? The Lord tees it up this way: "I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of Egypt, the land of slavery." The Lord begins with who He is, and everything that follows gives expression to who we are in relationship to Him. Jesus: relationship or religion? Jesus came to be faithful in keeping all the requirements of God for us so that He would establish a personal relationship with us that will last an eternity.

This Series: "Promises, Promises" - "For no matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ. And so through him the "Amen" is spoken by us to the glory of God" (2 Corinthians 1:20). During these Sundays during the season of Lent, we have the opportunity to ponder the faithfulness of our God. He is the keeper of promises. Lent is a 40-day preparation for Easter. Easter is the pinnacle of the kept promises of God—Jesus had not only stated that He would go to the cross, but He promised that He would rise again in victory.
