Today: "Rebel, Repent, Rescue, Repeat" - Numbers 21:4-9; Ephesians 2:1-10; John 3:14-21 • God's people in the wilderness had a pattern: they would rebel, repent, God would rescue them, and later there would be an event where this pattern would repeat. Not unlike some of the patterns in our own lives, the Israelites would test God's goodness by going their own way. The natural consequences they'd experience would be a reminder that they were unable to deliver themselves, let alone stay on the path. God's greatest deliverance is found in the sending of His Son into the world, giving life to all who would trust in Him. What situation is too big for you to handle on your own today? Hand it over, in faith, to Jesus, our deliverer.

"Promises, Promises" - "For no matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ. And so through him the "Amen" is spoken by us to the glory of God" (2 Corinthians 1:20). During these Sundays during the season of Lent, we have the opportunity to ponder the faithfulness of our God. He is the keeper of promises. Lent is a 40-day preparation for Easter. Easter is the pinnacle of the kept promises of God—Jesus had not only stated that He would go to the cross, but He promised that He would rise again in victory.
