Ultimately, they ask for gift cards or money so they might “discretely” help someone with a need. **Please do not respond to those emails or text messages; they are not from the pastors or staff members.** Remember, Pastor Ken, Pastor Adolfo and the staff will never send an “urgent” message pressuring you to “discretely” convey money, gift cards, or share any personal information.
