Jesus Christ, who gave his very life for us on the cross, walks with us as we mourn. In the name of Christ, God forgives our iniquity and remembers our sin no more. By grace you have been saved. Go now in faith to live as servants in the midst of a suffering world, boldly sharing the love of Christ with all.

All: Amen.

+ PRAYER OF THE DAY

WL: The Lord be with you.

All: And also with you.

WL: Let us pray. Sustaining God, who shelters us in our time of storm: Open our eyes to the presence of your Holy Spirit in our midst. Give us strength to serve even in our suffering, and remind us that you are the victor over sin, death, and the devil, through Jesus Christ, our Savior and Lord.

R: Our first lesson on this Twenty-first Sunday after Pentecost is from the fifth chapter of the prophet Amos.

Seek the Lord and live,
or he will sweep through the tribes of Joseph like a fire;
it will devour them, and Bethel will have no one to guench it.

There are those who turn justice into bitterness and cast righteousness to the ground.

There are those who hate the one who upholds justice in court and detest the one who tells the truth.

You levy a straw tax on the poor and impose a tax on their grain.

Therefore, though you have built stone mansions, you will not live in them; though you have planted lush vineyards, you will not drink their wine.

For I know how many are your offenses and how great your sins.

There are those who oppress the innocent and take bribes and deprive the poor of justice in the courts.

Therefore the prudent keep quiet in such times, for the times are evil.

Seek good, not evil, that you may live.

Then the Lord God Almighty will be with you, just as you say he is.

Hate evil, love good; maintain justice in the courts.

Perhaps the Lord God Almighty will have mercy on the remnant of Joseph.

All: Thanks be to God.

R: The Second lesson is from the third chapter of Hebrews.

See to it, brothers and sisters, that none of you has a sinful, unbelieving heart that turns away from the living God. But encourage one another daily, as long as it is called "Today," so that none of you may be hardened by sin's deceitfulness. We have come to share in Christ, if indeed we hold our original conviction firmly to the very end. As has just been said:

"Today, if you hear his voice, do not harden your hearts as you did in the rebellion."

Who were they who heard and rebelled? Were they not all those Moses led out of Egypt? And with whom was he angry for forty years? Was it not with those who sinned, whose bodies perished in the wilderness? And to whom did God swear that they would never enter his rest if not to those who disobeyed? So we see that they were not able to enter, because of their unbelief.
