Today: "He Knows Just What You Need: A Connection with Jesus" • Readings: Luke 3:15-22; Isaiah 43:1-7; Romans 6:1-11 • Today we commemorate the Baptism of our Lord. We celebrate how Jesus completely connected with our humanity by being baptized along "with all the people." Jesus forged a connection with us the day we were baptized. The gift of the Holy Spirit comes to us and the Father's declaration covers us: We, too, are beloved children of God, with whom He is well pleased. Being connected with Jesus is just what we need. How would you explain that to someone? How can you live that every day?
