January 11, 2026 The Baptism of our Lord

Today: "True Identity" • Readings: Matthew 3:13–17; Romans 6:1–11; Isaiah 42:1–9 • Jesus came to identify with all humanity, taking on our flesh and stepping into our story—even entering a baptism of repentance He did not need. In the Jordan, He stands with sinners so that He might "fulfill all righteousness" for us, and the Father reveals Him as the beloved Son while the Spirit descends upon Him. Joined to Jesus in our own baptism, that identity becomes ours as well: beloved, claimed, and renewed. And as God's children, we begin to live from that identity—secure in His love and attentive to the people around us whom God places in our path.
