Today: "The Blessing People" • Matthew 5:1-12; Micah 6:1-8; 1 Corinthians 1:18-31 • Jesus begins His sermon on the mount by reminding His disciples who they are—their identity as God's people: they are blessed. What do you think would happen if all those who follow Jesus saw themselves, first and foremost, as "the blessing people?" *God's blessing isn't found in what we achieve, earn, or hold—it's who we are in Christ. And because of this identity, we spread Jesus' blessings everywhere we go.*
