Today: "What Are We and What Are We Doing Here" • Titus 3:3-8; Luke 19:1-10 • Jesus is on a mission to restore and redeem *all* people, in short because God wants His world back. Jesus calls us to follow Him and look for people who need God's love. Jesus is already at work, and He has us right where He wants us in our neighborhoods and community. While we can't save people, we can love them where they are and have joy in participating in Jesus' redemptive mission.

Our Guest Speaker this weekend is Pastor Greg Finke, author of the "Joining Jesus" book series. Pastor Finke leads Dwelling 1:14, a ministry that comes alongside pastors and leaders to help them intentionally disciple their people to join Jesus on His mission in the places they already live, work and go to school. Pastor Finke will also be leading our adult Bible class this morning.
