TODAY: "Take Nothing" • Matthew 9:35-10:20; Exodus 19:2-8; Romans 5:6-15 • We live in a culture that prizes self-sufficiency. We are taught to carry our own weight, meet our own needs, and depend on no one. Yet, Jesus sends His disciples out with nothing. No financial security. No backup plan. No guarantee of welcome. They are to trust God, receive the hospitality of strangers, and freely give what they have freely received. The kingdom of God grows not through power, wealth, or control, but through vulnerability, generosity, and faith. Perhaps one of the hardest lessons for modern Christians is that God's kingdom advances when we need one another.
